About the Baker Neighborhood and BHNA— the Baker Historic Neighborhood Association

Baker is named for James H. Baker, principal of Denver's first high school and president of University of Colorado 1892–1915. BHNA is a Denver Registered Neighborhood Organization serving residents and property owners from 6th Ave. to Mississippi Ave., and from Lincoln St. to the South Platte River.

Approximately 6000 residents live in this area, which also includes major industrial and commercial uses, the Alameda and the Broadway RTD light rail stations, two highways, a major railroad line and two Denver Public Schools—Fairmont Dual Immersion Academy and the Denver Center for International Studies. The southern portion of the Santa Fe Arts District extends into Baker along Santa Fe & Kalamath. Approximately 30 blocks of the residential portion of Baker were designated a Denver Historic Landmark District in 2000. Three buildings along the Broadway corridor, which is outside the Landmark District, are individually designated landmarks.

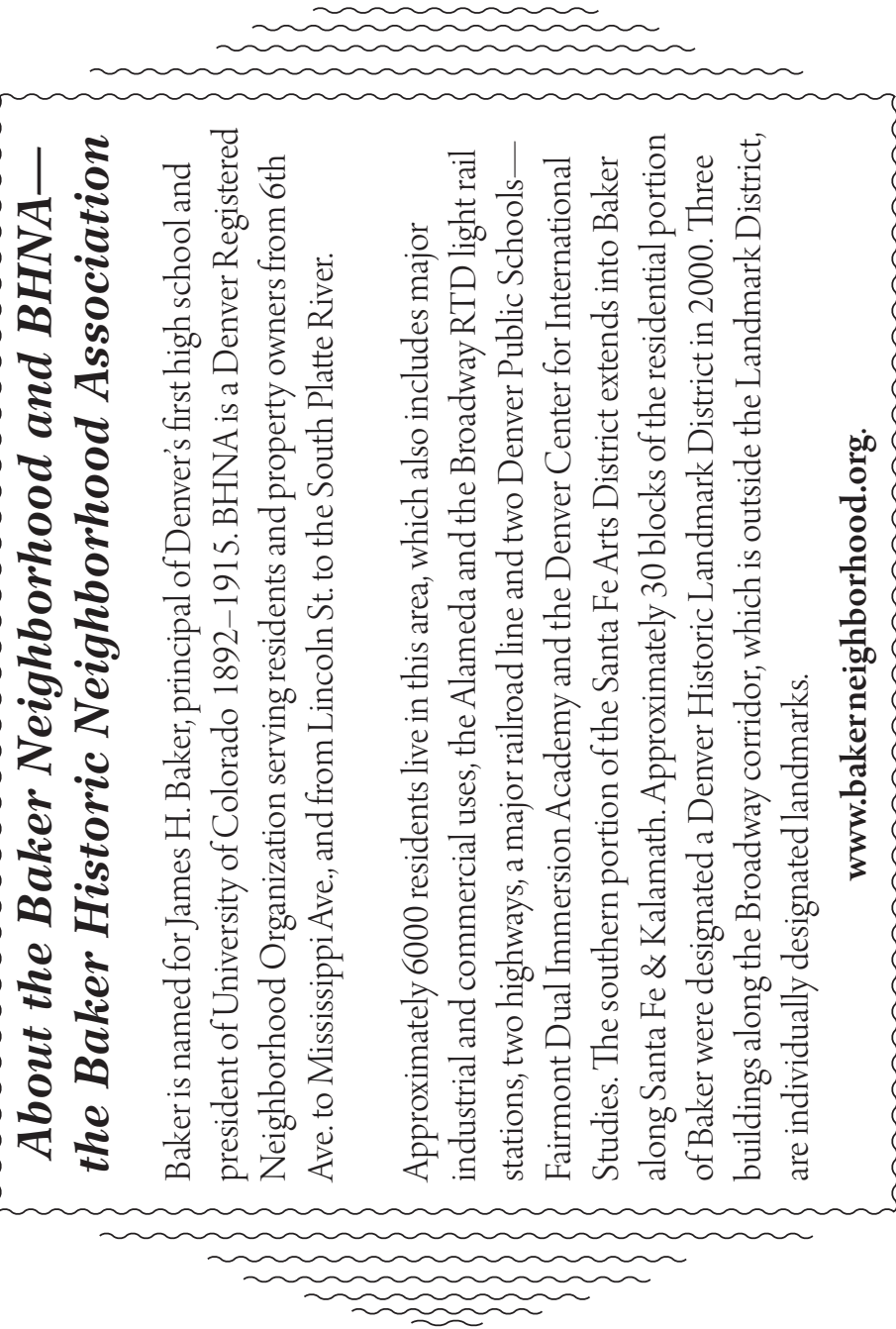
